FLOWER BED CLEAN UP

Spring is finally here! This also means it's time to clean up landscaping, including Owners making sure that there flower beds are cleaned up. Please make sure that all flower beds are weeded (including lawn that creeps into flower beds), raked, flowers cleaned up and pulled if needs be, and top soil is added to flower beds that are low. It is recommended to add top soil at least every couple of years to keep levels up and soil rich and nutrient for plants, flowers and bushes to thrive. All flower beds should be initially maintained before the Board Landscape Inspection in June and then continue throughout the season.

Any Owner that does not wish to maintain their flower bed or are unable for any reason should obtain the service of someone, to care for your flower bed.
