Top Soil/Compost

For those interested, maintenance can bring in extra top soil or compost (owner choice) with minimal bark to place around the flower beds. Each unit is responsible to pay for the top soil or compost (owner choice) and the Association will pay for the application process (dig out available at additional fee at owners expense.)

Top Soil: \$32/yard Compost: \$25/yard

(Bark or Rock requires board approval and is paid for

solely by owner)

Stand alone unit: approx. 6 yards Double unit: approx. 3 yards
