## **Snow Removal**

Winter is on its way! A couple things to note when it comes to snow removal.

- 1. Snow removal for all streets are done by the City.
- 2. Driveways and sidewalks will be cleared by the HOA when 2"-3" of snow fall occurs. Front walkways and anything less than 2" will be owner responsibility to plow if necessary.
- 3. Applying Ice Melt: Each owner will be responsible to supply and apply their own ice melt to driveways and front walkways if needed. We do recommend that this is done sparingly as ice melt can be harmful to concrete.
