Pool Rules & Regulations

Pool Hours: 11:00 to 9:00PM (All Ages)

Adult ONLY Pool Hours: Daily 9:00AM-11:00AM

Pool Closes at 8:30 starting August 16th –Subject to Change

Season Fee: \$45 (Due with agreement)

Pool Capacity: 25

Members: Are permanent resident homeowners or full time residents in good standing, and their immediate family members permanently residing at Sherwood Park. Members are responsible for the safety, welfare, and Adults are persons at least 18 years of age.

Management: These Rules and Regulations will be enforced uniformly and fairly to each individual. The pool manager, members of the swimming pool advisory committee and Association Board Members have complete authority in the pool area at all times. Failure to abide by the Pool Rules & Regulations will result in forfeiture of pool privileges for 30 days and a \$50 fine.

The rules & regulations of the swimming pool area will be posted in the pool area. Additional copies of the pool rules and regulations are available on the Association website www.goldenspikerealty.com/sherwoodpark, from a Board Member or Management.

Misconduct of a homeowner, member of his/her family or guest will constitute grounds for immediate exclusion from the pool and loss of pool privileges for the homeowners and his/her family or guest for 30 days & a \$50 fine.

The Pool is a designated smoke free area.

Trash: All trash must be cleaned up and taken out by the resident each time used. If you pack it in, you pack it out.

Registration: Homeowners & residents must fill out & submit a registration form which identifies all eligible family members who are permanent residents of Sherwood Park and authorized to use the swimming pool. Upon receipts of this registration form and pool fee, a code will be issued to all homeowners/residents in good standing, allowing entrance to the pool area. Homeowners who are delinquent, or become delinquent in their maintenance & assessment fees will be denied pool privileges.

Pool Sign In: All homeowners/residents and their authorized resident family members must register/sign in at the Pool Log Book upon entry to the pool area. The Log Book is located in the pool area adjacent to the pool gate. Adult members will write their name, time of entry, address and list their number of guests each time they use the pool. Immediate family members must be listed in conjunction with the homeowner's name.

Guest Policy: One adult owner/full time resident may bring **5 guests per unit into the pool area**. Guests are defined as anyone not permanently residing in Sherwood Park. Member's children under age of 18 may NOT have guests in the pool area. Residents **18-21** years old are allowed 2 guests, up to a total of 5 guests per unit. **ALL GUESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED IN THE POOL AREA BY AN ADULT HOMEOWNER AT ALL TIMES.** If an adult homeowner is not physically present in the pool area to supervise his/her guest at all time, the guest will immediately be denied the use of the pool and pool area.

Conduct, Health & Safety

1. No lifeguard is on duty at the pool. Therefore all children under the age of 14 years must be supervised by an adult permanent owner/resident. State Law and Insurance requirement.
2. If you feel sick in any way, **DO NOT USE OR ENTER THE POOL AREA.**
3. Oil base skin or suntan lotions are NOT to be used in the pool. Silicone lotions are recommended when using the pool.
4. Shoes must be worn at all times when entering or leaving to reenter the pool area.
5. Only swim suites will be permitted in the pool. Cut-offs, Levis, shorts, shoes, etc are not allowed in the pool.
6. All Children under 3 years old and those children not toilet trained must wear swim-diapers and plastic covers over the swim diaper in the pool. **NO EXCEPTION!**
7. Horseplay is absolutely forbidden. No running or boisterous play will be permitted in the pool or within the pool area at any time.
8. A space of six feet around the edge of the pool and must be maintained clear of sun bathers, chairs, mats, etc.
9. Children who have accumulated sand, dirt, or food on their bodies must first wash before entering the pool. Children may not run back and forth between the pool and the playground.
10. Rafts and other pool items must be kept to a minimum and may not be left in the pool area at any time. Only pool approved items should be used. Please be respectful and allow room for others to use the pool. Deck chairs, lounges, towels, and other recreational items must be provided by the

individual members, and must be taken home following each pool use;
remember these must be more than six feet from the edge of the pool.
Do not put towels, shoes, or bags on the tables.

11. Children must be supervised to assure proper use of the restroom. Urination in the pool is strictly prohibited. Defecating in the pool will mandate immediate closure of the pool for one or more days for appropriate decontamination.
12. No one is allowed in the pool area who has a fever, skin infection, open sore, inflamed eyes, or who is wearing a bandage or adhesive tape.
13. Food and drink is allowed inside the pool compound only in designated areas, which are limited under the canopy area or on the lawn. No food is allowed on the pool deck. All beverages must be consumed at least six feet from the edge of the pool. **Beverages and foods must be in non-glass containers.** Pool area users must clean up after themselves (beverage containers, paper) Spills should be washed off immediately and tables left clean.
14. Contaminants will not be placed or thrown in the pool. Contaminants are defined as beverages, food, towels, shoes, clothing, etc. No objects such as rocks, coins, or hard surfaced objects that can mar the bottom of the pool will be allowed in the pool area. Pool specific toys only.
15. Dogs, cats or any other pets are prohibited in the pool area.
16. Any types of vehicle, i.e. bicycle, tricycle, skate board or skate shoe is prohibited from being in the pool area at any time.
17. The pool area may be closed at any time that the pool is unsafe or reasons such as thunderstorms, lightening, contaminants, equipment failure, or other outside influences that could be determined detrimental to the safety and welfare of individuals. No one is allowed in pool area when the **“Pool Closed”** sign is posted at the pool gate.
